

Eligibility

To be considered for an apprenticeship with Territory Generation applicants must:

- Demonstrate an understanding of safety and a commitment to upholding safety standards.
- Have an aptitude to be able to follow written instructions and undertake the theory component of the apprenticeship.
- Demonstrate a genuine desire to pursue a career in this trade/industry.
- Have good written and verbal communication skills.
- Hold a current NT C class driver's license.
- Applicants that are shortlisted are also required to complete and pass numeric, abstract and mechanical reasoning aptitude tests.

General Information

Apprenticeships combine both on-the-job learning and theory based learning.

- Apprenticeships are generally 4 years in length however this does vary and is dependent on the individual's abilities and commitment to the program.
- Apprentices are required to attend trade school which is generally 2-week blocks spent at Charles Darwin University, learning the theory based elements of the trade. These blocks are evenly spread throughout the program.
- On-the-job learning is via coaching and mentoring in the workplace with skilled professionals and also consists of an out posted placement with local contractors.
- Territory Generation has multiple locations where apprentices are required including, Darwin, Katherine, Tennant Creek, Alice Spring and Yulara.
- Apprentices receive excellent pay and conditions, additional training and development outside of the apprenticeship requirements, and have access to programs including the Health and Well Being, and Reward and Recognition programs.
