Eligibility

- Must be a current full time University student
- Be studying at an Australian recognised University
- Studying a discipline relevant to the requirements of Territory Generation
- Be in a minimum of their 2nd year of study
- Be eligible to work in Australia for the duration of the program (appropriate working visa)

Territory Generation offers students studying university degrees the option of completing paid short term work placements during mid semester and end of year university breaks. These opportunities offer students the ability to:

- Develop skills and knowledge within a power generation environment.
- Gain real life experience and industry knowledge in a professional working environment.
- Apply the methods and theories learned through university to real life situations in a controlled environment.
- Be better prepared for the progression from the university environment to the Graduate program upon completion of their degree.
