Role Responsibilities

You will provide professional economic, financial and analytical services and guidance regarding the commercial business activities of Territory Generation.

Your accountabilities include:

- 1. Perform demand forecasting, market analysis and revenue modelling for budgets, monthly, quarterly and annual reporting and forecasts.
- 2. Prepare the monthly revenue calculations, reconciliations, billing processes and accruals.
- 3. Ensure the timely and accurate preparation of monthly invoices for all customers.
- 4. Prepare the monthly revenue and energy analysis, price and volume analysis and reporting to the Board.
- 5. Provide economic analysis and advice in regard to input costs, sales price, product demand and general economic conditions and prepare recommended strategic responses.
- 6. Undertake research and analysis into the commercial viability of major capital works, new business development proposals and proposals for private sector involvement in provision of the Corporation's services.
- 7. Analyse and recommend risk management and mitigation strategies associated with major capital works and new business development proposals.
- 8. Ensure that the Corporation maintains a focus on the commercial outcomes required under the Government Owned Corporations legislation as well as those contained in the Statement of Corporate Intent.
- 9. Undertake Renewable Energy Certificates (REC) calculations and recording in the ledger.
- 10. Carry out duties in accordance with Territory Generation's safety, environmental and quality policy, safety principles, corporate values and strategies.

Selection Criteria

Essential

- 1. Demonstrated ability undertaking commercial analysis with working knowledge of commercial business analysis techniques including investment analysis, statistical trends and forecasting, financial modelling, cost and management accounting.
- 2. Good knowledge of utility pricing principles, tariff structures and levels of charges and the key factors impacting product and service demand.
- 3. Sound knowledge and skills in policy development, quality management principles and performance monitoring and reporting frameworks.
- 4. Well-developed information technology knowledge and skills including the use of word processing and spreadsheet software packages as well as project management tools and relevant mainframe applications.
- 5. Strong verbal and writing skills enabling effective communication with senior management across the Corporation, including both operational and financial areas.
- 6. Ability to work in a team, prioritise and manage competing demands to deliver outcomes and create a positive working environment.
- 7. Ability to carry out duties in accordance with Territory Generation's safety, environmental and quality policies and corporate values and strategies.
