



# Engineering Diversity Scholarship Program

Territory Generation and Engineers Australia have partnered to provide a \$6,000 scholarship program to foster diversity in the engineering sector. Two scholarships, worth a total of \$3,000 each, will be offered in 2018 over two semesters. One scholarship will be awarded to an Indigenous Australian enrolled in a Bachelor of Engineering at Charles Darwin University and the other will be awarded to a female enrolled in a Bachelor of Engineering at Charles Darwin University. Scholarship recipients will also be given the opportunity to undertake valuable work placements with Territory Generation during 2018's semester breaks.
